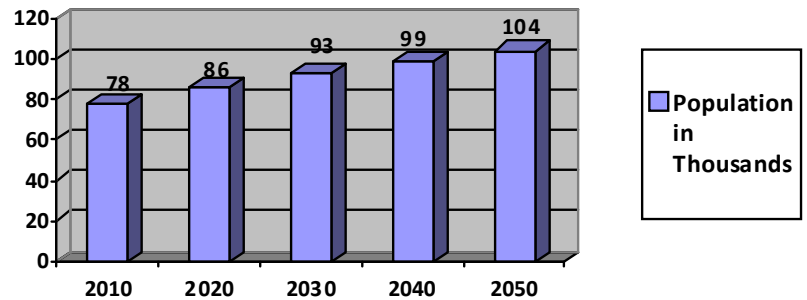

Population Projections - Apache County



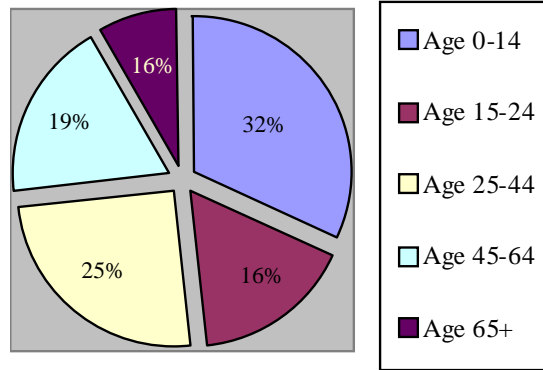

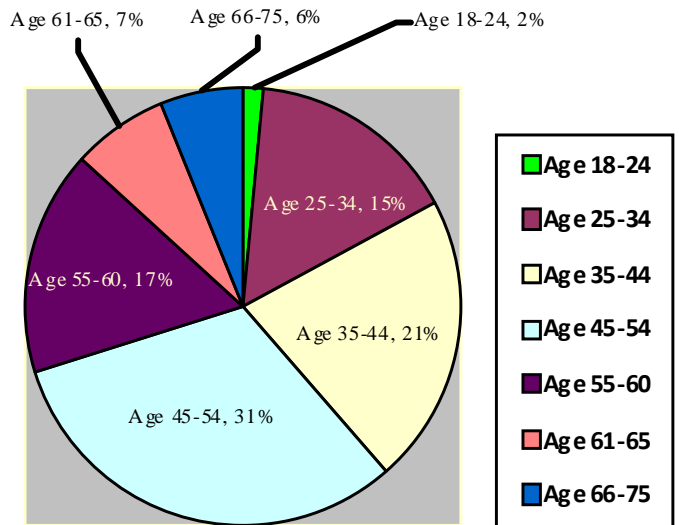

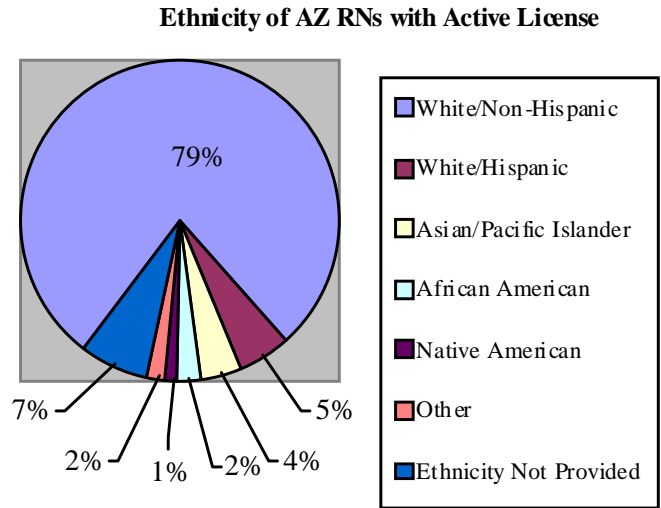

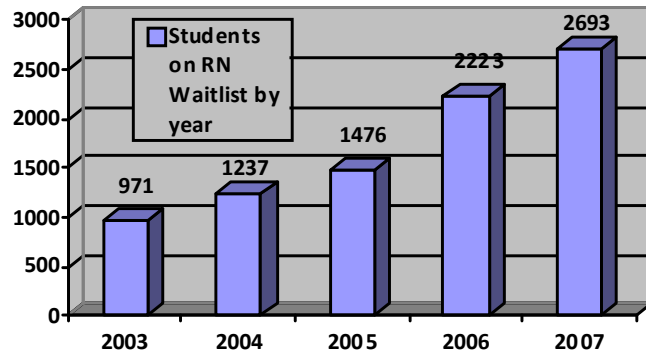

RN program waitlist by year (Arizona)

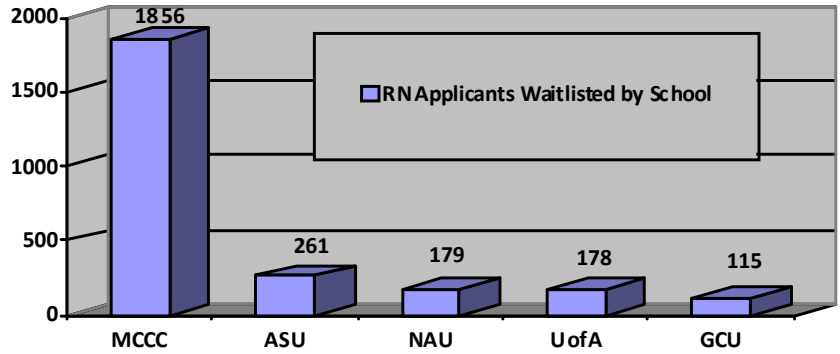

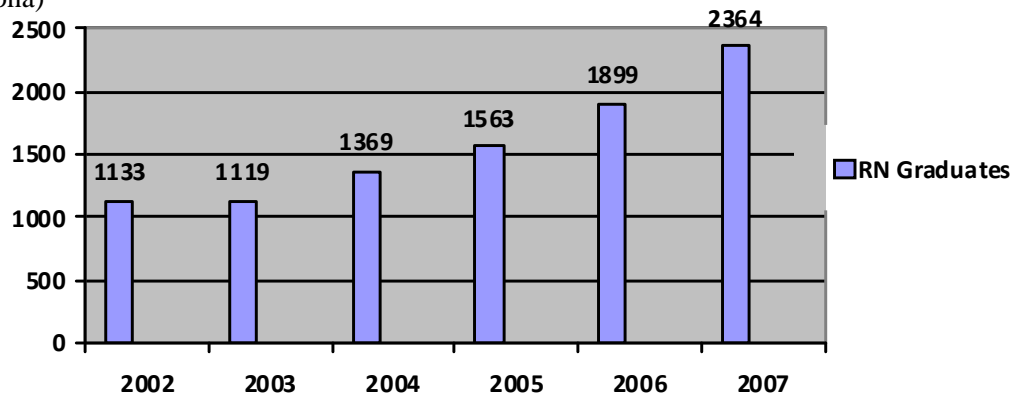
