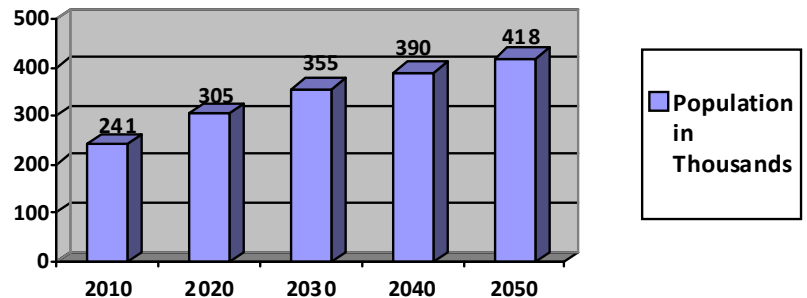

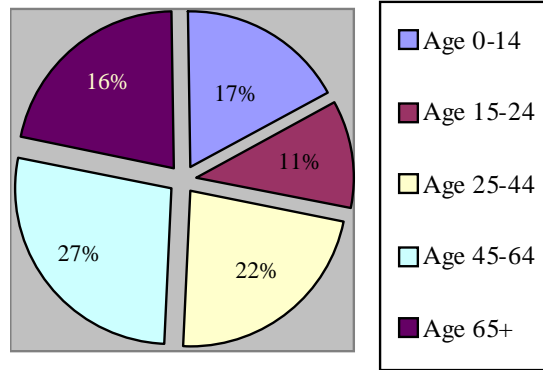

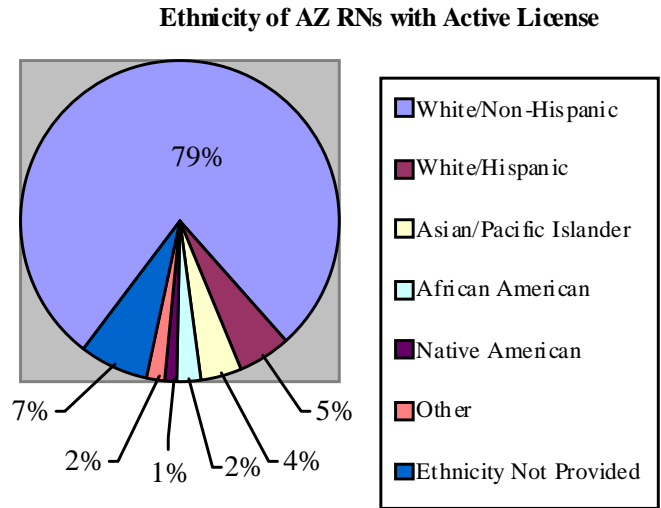

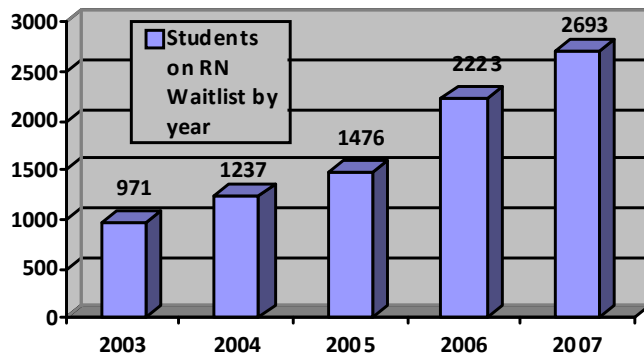

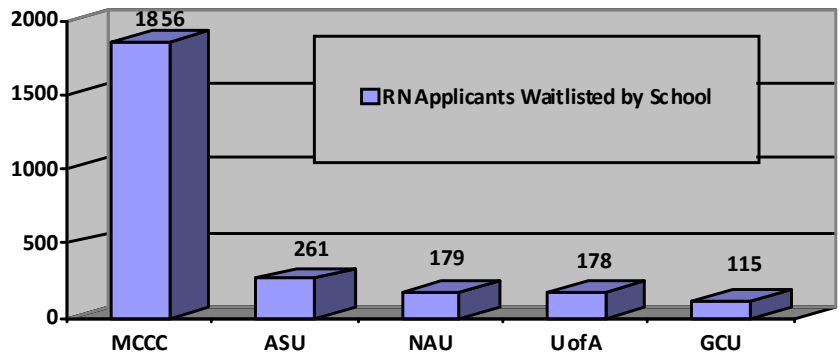
RN program waitlist by year (Arizona)

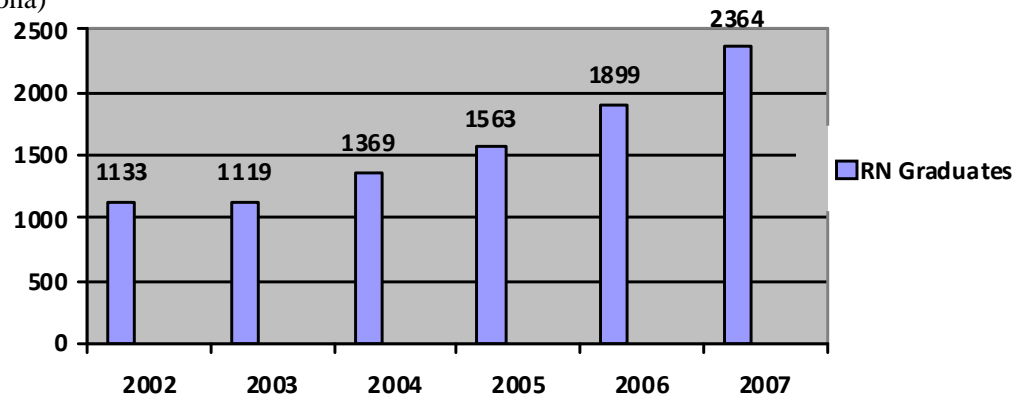
