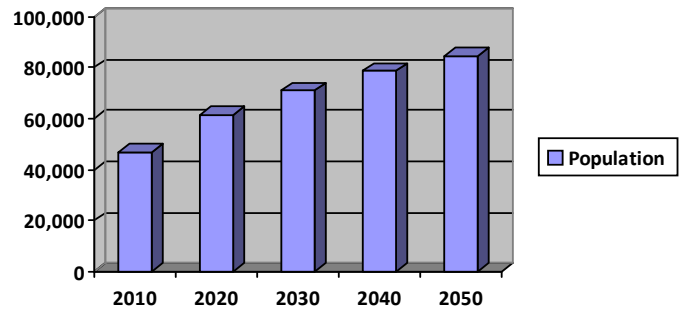

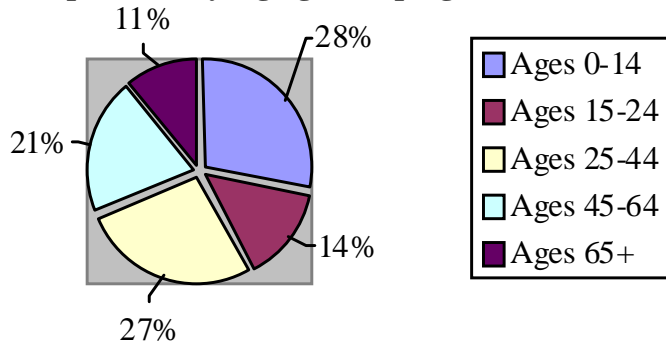

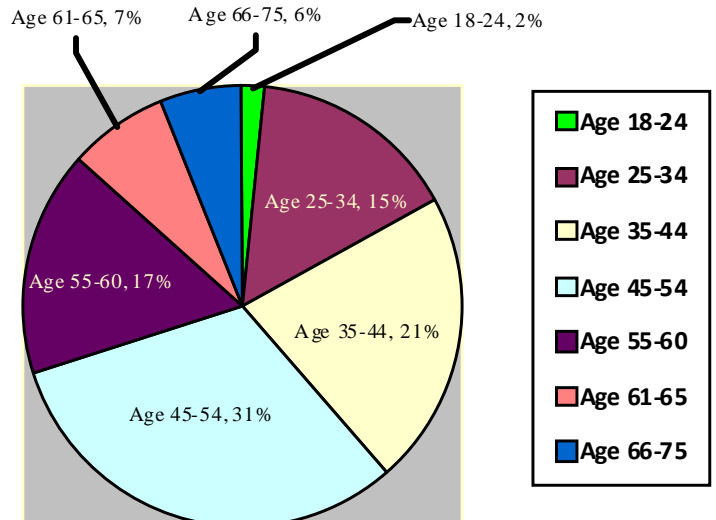

**Age Group of AZ RNs with Active License**

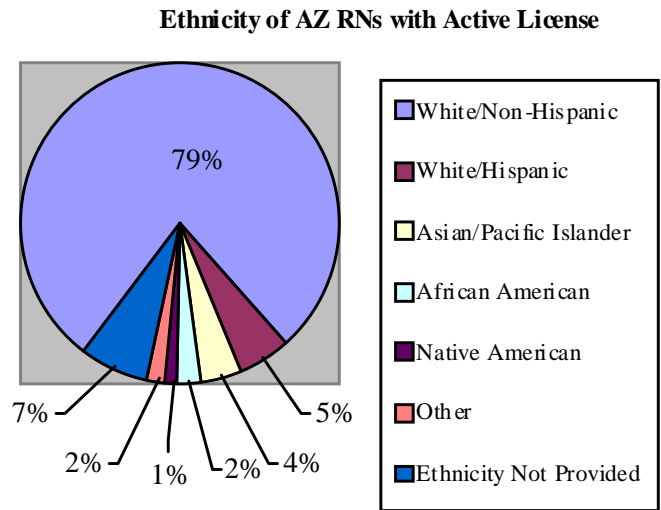

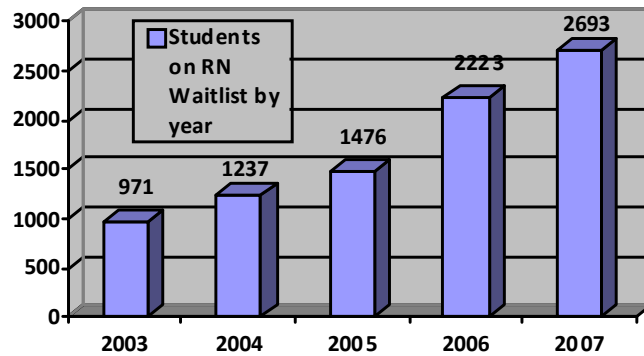

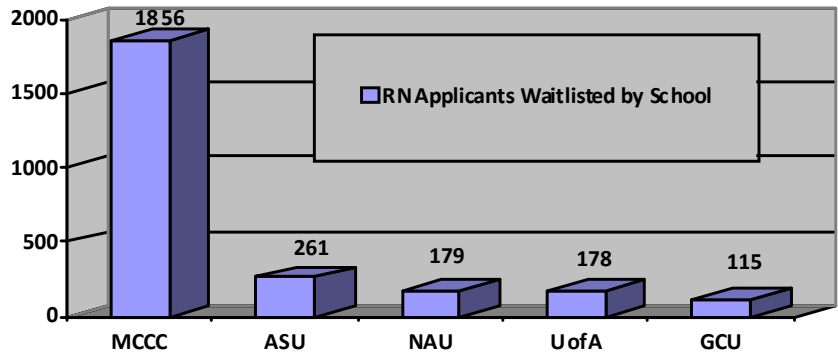

- RN program admissions by program for the state (A.D.N./B.S.N.)
 

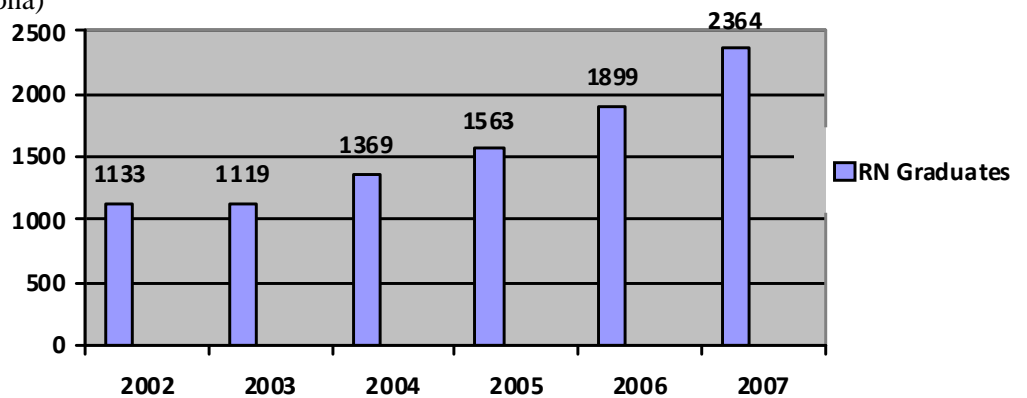
